	Additional information:  Outdoor classes in the field of painting and drawing for students of the first year of the Faculty of Architecture, aimed at shaping basic painting skills. It is a continuation of the study of painting composition based on the observation of the mutual relations of colors and the influence of light and shadow on the color of an object. Four tasks are carried out on the basis of observations from nature: Seaside landscape, Park, My City, Shipyard. Students make painting sketches, which are the starting point for the implementation of study works. Each exercise is preceded by a discussion of the topic and a short lecture. Students learn basic concepts related to painting, such as: painting composition, warm colors, cool colors, color dominant, color contrast, color range. Students continue to learn the basics of the tempera painting technique, which they learned in the second semester.
