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Subject contents	The diploma seminar is organized in the form of a study trip and its summary. During the summary, the projects presented during the trip will be presented and the main planning and organizational aspects related to the topic of the trip will be discussed. Methodically, the seminar prepares students to use tools such as case studies to conduct design, research and scientific work. Study trip The aim of the trip will be to show different approaches to shaping new complexes of multi-functional buildings and public spaces. The main topic of the trip is the issue of recovering urban spaces through revitalization projects implemented in the existing urban tissue, taking into account existing historical resources or through the expansion of new housing complexes. We will look at projects that result in the construction of new parts of the city - mixed-use buildings, shopping centers and apartment buildings, as well as public utilities. Public spaces will be an important point of the program. The trip will be organized to two cities: Warsaw and Łódź. These cities differ in their history. Łódź was affected by the negative effects of the political transformation, but has been undergoing revitalization over the last decade. Its elements included activities of the public side, private investors and NGOs. The trip will present each of these aspects through case studies and conversations with designers responsible for these projects. Warsaw is the main city of Poland, the only true metropolis. Taking a look at the projects being implemented will allow us to see how the capital's most dynamic real estate market and the actions of the Warsaw authorities have responded to the capital's development challenges. In Warsaw, we will look at both modern projects on the left bank of the Vistula in the office heart of Wola, as well as projects in the revitalized part of Praga.
