	Students learn to communicate effectively with future colleagues, instructors and clients. Students are prepared to create and conduct a presentation, administration arguments for and against, asking questions, checking information.

	Everyday life and work environment vocabulary are to develop listening skills in different situations. Students learn to listen in order to understand the specific information.
