Subject contents	Wstęp do prawa gospodarczego realizowany jest w zakresie wybranych zagadnień. W celu poprawnego przyswajania wiedzy i odczytywania norm prawnych wykład zawiera wprowadzenie z zakresu prawoznawstwa podstawowych pojęć prawnych, w szczególności informacji o źródłach prawa i ich wykładni. W zasadniczej tematyce prawa gospodarczego skoncentrowano się na kwestii regulacji działalności gospodarczej.
