Subject contents	The subject allows the student to understand the nature of an investment project, how to evaluate its effectiveness and the sources of its financing. Particular attention will be paid to the structure of documentation evaluating the validity and profitability of individual projects. The student will also learn about the sources of investment financing in terms of national and EU (pre-accession and accession) funds. The programming periods of structural funds and the structural allocation of funds will be characterized. Project work will include the preparation of a feasibility study of a selected project.
