Counting, simple mathematical operations. Naming and describing objects. Indicating items. Expressing possession. Naming colours. A simple description of a person. Questions about the price, buying (in very simple situations). Vocabulary and Grammar: Alphabet. Verbs of the first and second groups. Irregular verbs: être, avoir, aller, faire. Reflexive verbs: s'appeler. The expression "il y a". Articles: definite and indefinite. Masculine and feminine nouns and adjectives. Prepositions en / au / aux + name of the country. Pronouns: personal, possessive, interrogative, indicative, strong. Prepositions of place. Negation. Polite forms. Professions, nationality, names of objects. Numbers, arithmetic operations, date. Cities, countries, regions. The members of the family. Basic adjectives, basic vocabulary related to shopping.
