Subject contents	Course content – exercises Repetition and/or introduction of basic grammatical structures (articles, plural forms, verbs in the present tense, word order). Everyday vocabulary and phrases: introducing yourself, family, studies, free time, shopping, traveling. Communication in student life situations: at university, in the dormitory, in the office, in class. Listening comprehension short dialogues and authentic recordings, exercises in picking up general and specific information. Reading short functional texts (advertisements, emails, simple articles) and discussing them. Speaking exercises: dialogues in pairs, role-playing, short presentations about yourself and your field of study. Writing simple texts: emails, forms, short descriptions, notes, messages to lecturers/colleagues. Elements of specialized language related to the field of study (basic technical vocabulary). Selected topics in realia: German-speaking countries, education system, academic culture, customs.

Example issues/ example questions/ tasks being completed	Introduce yourself in German (name, country of origin, field of study) and ask your classmate at least three questions about their studies or free time. Act out a dialogue "at the university" a student asks the office about the class schedule, course completion, and consultation times. Write a short email to the lecturer in German asking for an explanation of the homework assignment or a postponement of the exam date. Fill out a simple form (registration form, university registration form, course registration form) based on the personal and student data provided. Read a short text about the education system in Germany/Austria/Switzerland and answer questions in writing to test your understanding. Expand your vocabulary: prepare a mini-glossary (10-15 words) related to your field of study and use them in 3-4 sentences about yourself. Listen to a short recording of a dialogue from student life and write down the most important information (who? where? when? for what purpose?). Prepare a short oral presentation (23 minutes) about yourself, your field of study, and your career plans in German. Complete the sentences with the appropriate verb form / preposition / article exercises to reinforce grammatical structures. Compare in a few sentences (written or oral) selected elements of student life in Poland and in a German-speaking country.
