Heat distribution networks and district heating substations. Designed heat load of buildings. Central heating systems. Guidelines for design and calculations of central heating systems. Hydraulic control. Heating pipes and their thermal insulation. Pressure losses in the pipes. Radiators. Hot tap water systems. Passive buildings. Application of refrigeration units and heat pumps. Design and working principles of a compressor refrigeration plant. Direct and indirect cooling systems. Refrigerants and heat carriers: selected properties. Interaction of basic elements in cooling systems. Selected operational problems in refrigeration. Ventilation systems in buildings. Ventilation systems of industrial spaces. Methods of calculating supply and exhaust streams. Designing ducts. Equipment selection. The aim and application of air conditioning. Comfort and industrial air conditioning. Moist air - characteristics, Mollier chart. Calculation of the thermal load of objects - heat gains and losses. The necessary amount of supply air (including fresh air). Examples of air conditioning systems solutions. Recovery systems demands in air conditioning systems.
